FIRST FRUITS OF ZION 2017 MODERN ISRAEL TOUR ■ APRIL 23 TO MAY 4, 2017

COST—with departure from Newark, NJ, \$4,500. A land-only cost is available for \$3,540.

RESERVATIONS—A \$500 non-refundable deposit and the completed Registration Form will enroll you in this tour so long as space remains. The remaining balance of \$4,000/\$3,040 is due at the FFOZ office by March 5, 2017.

AIR TRANSPORTATION—Round-trip group fare on regularly scheduled commercial flights from the USA; after tickets are issued, they are non-refundable.

CANCELLATIONS—Cancellation will result in forfeiture of deposit and balance paid. If FFOZ should elect to cancel prior to departure, a full refund will be issued.

TRAVEL INSURANCE—is required. (One option is www.travelguard.com.) FFOZ requires ALL travelers to have either health insurance or travel insurance prior to departure.

PASSPORT—must be valid 6 months beyond date of re-entry into the USA. Apply for your passport now; FFOZ must have your passport number and name exactly as it appears on your passport by November 4, 2017. Visas are issued upon arrival at the airport in Israel at no cost.

VACCINATIONS & IMMUNIZATIONS—are not required for Israel.

HOTELS—9 nights in Israel—Four-star first-class hotels and kibbutz hotels are based on sharing twin-bedded rooms with private bath. Single rooms (limited number) are available at an additional cost of \$1,150. Single travelers will be matched with a suitable, same-sex roommate, and triple-occupancy may be formed in cases of odd numbers of same-sex travelers.

YOUR LUGGAGE—(one suitcase) will be handled for you upon arrival in Israel, transferred between hotels, and back to the airport. One carry-on that fits under the plane seat or in the overhead bin is permitted.

RESPONSIBILITY—Neither FFOZ, JBSS, tour guides and hosts and their agents shall be liable for any injury, damage, loss, accident, delay, or irregularity which may be occasioned, whether by reasons of defect in any vehicle or through acts of default of any company or persons engaged in conveying the passenger or in connection therewith or of any hotel proprietor or servant. Such conveying, etc., is subject to the laws of the country where the conveyance, etc., is provided. The aforesaid entities can accept no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay or changes in transportation, company service, sickness, weather, strikes, war, quarantines, or other causes. All such losses or expense will have to be borne by the passenger. The tour host reserves the right to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of the tour whose mental or physical condition or general deportment impedes the operation of the tour or affects the rights, welfare, or enjoyment of other tour passengers. The right is also reserved to cancel or alter the tour if circumstances require it. All arrangements for air transportation are made by the airlines concerned, which are not to be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not on board their planes or conveyances. The passenger contract in use by the airlines concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airlines and the purchasers of this tour and/or passengers. No responsibility of any kind attaches to FFOZ, JBSS, or their representatives, or any of the persons or companies mentioned above, or any agent, associate, or employee thereof.

RATES INCLUDE—Round-trip flights from Newark, NJ (EWR) to Tel Aviv (TLV); nine nights accommodation at first class hotels; air-conditioned tour bus; dynamic, knowledgeable, and friendly tour guide; entry fees to all sites (as listed on the itinerary); all tips; breakfasts and dinners daily; airport pick-up and drop-off.

RATES DO NOT INCLUDE—Beverages; lunches; extra hotel services (phone calls, room service, laundry, etc.); single hotel room supplement (\$1,150); passports; travel insurance; voluntary “Love Offering” for guide and driver; anything else not specifically listed as included.

PAYMENT—All payments should be mailed and made out to tour organizer, FFOZ. A \$500 deposit is due upon registration. Full payment and final registration are due on or before March 5, 2017. Any bookings without full payment at this time may be subject to cancellation. All prices are quoted in US Dollars. A price increase may be applied if the US Dollar to Israeli Shekel exchange rate fluctuates by 5% or more as of March 5, 2017 or for government tax and fee increases, or for unforeseeable circumstances. You will be notified immediately upon discovery of an increase and will have the option of paying the difference or canceling with full refund.

ACCOMMODATIONS—Price is based on double occupancy. Single rooms, when available, are often smaller than double rooms. While we will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee a double-occupancy-only rooming situation. In cases where an odd number of same-sex travelers are present, triple-room occupancy will be assigned. Single room occupancy is available for \$1,150 before March 5, 2017.

FLIGHTS, ROUTES, AND TICKETING—Flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. JBSS is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. To keep prices low, JBSS does not guarantee the most direct routing to your destination. Flights will be economy class, non-amendable, non-refundable, for groups of 10 or more on the same itinerary. Once ticketed, flights cannot be changed or refunded.

ADDITIONAL AIRLINE FEES—You may incur additional airline fees at check-in or on board for excess baggage, food, personal items, etc. We highly recommend bringing only one suitcase to check-in and one carry-on bag for easy access to your luggage while on tour.

ITINERARY CHANGES—The course schedule is given in good faith, but it is subject to change to adapt to climate conditions, time limitations, or other circumstances at the discretion of the instructor. If flight itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, the fee is \$120 per night, single rooms \$195 per night including breakfast only, unless arranged independently, and tips and transfers are not included.

CANCELLATION FEES—Cancellations result in costly charges from travel and hotel providers. Therefore, the following fees will apply: Up to 120 days prior to departure, you will be refunded all funds paid except a \$100 administrative fee and any airline fees; 120–80 days = you will be charged the \$500 deposit plus any airline fees/penalties; 80–65 days = \$600 plus any airline fees/penalties; 65–31 days = 40% of total cost plus any airline fees/penalties; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. Also, if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single, you will be charged a single room supplement. Time of cancellation will be when notice is received in our Jerusalem office. (Please note that cancellation fees may be covered by your travel insurance plan provided the premium has been paid and the reason for cancellation is insurable.)

HEALTH & SPECIAL ASSISTANCE—All tour participants are required to have (and show proof of) travel insurance for this tour. The tour is active and may include a considerable amount of walking on uneven terrain. Travelers must be in good health. Consult your physician for pre-departure health advice. JBSS and FFOZ regret that we cannot provide individual assistance to guests for wheelchairs, motorized scooters, walking, dining, or other personal needs. Persons needing such assistance must be accompanied by an able companion who will assist them. We regret that wheelchairs and motorized scooters may face limitations on our tour. JBSS and FFOZ reserve the right to terminate the tour of any persons who are abusive of others or whose behavior disrupts the operation of the tour.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY—Except where otherwise stated, JBSS acts only as agent for the relevant supplier in securing flights, hotels, ground transportation, and other travel services, and in no event shall JBSS be liable for failure by any such supplier to render any transportation, lodging, or other travel service to be provided on the tour. JBSS assumes no liability for injury, death, damage, loss, accident, delay, or irregularity that may occur by reason of any negligent or willful act or omission of any suppliers of service. JBSS does not own or operate any of the suppliers of services to your tour. Similarly, without limiting the foregoing, passenger agrees to hold JBSS harmless for any defect in any vehicle, plane, boat, bus, car, van or other vehicle, act of war or insurrection, terrorist activity, revolt or other civil uprising, military action, strikes, or labor unrest or any act of God or for any other act of any third party.
