Shalom!

Zechariah envisioned that the LORD would be **universally recognized as King**, and his name would be unified only when Jews and Gentiles **worshiped the LORD in complete unison**. The prophecy’s context is Gentiles, *with palm branches in hand*, coming to Jerusalem to celebrate with the Jewish people at the Festival of Sukkot—at the time of ingathering.

**First Fruits of Zion has been actively laboring to make this prophecy a reality.** For more than thirty years, we’ve been teaching Christians about their prophetic destiny with Israel. We’ve been sharing that the key to Israel’s redemption depends on the nations aligning properly *today*, not tomorrow, with God’s promises to his people.

John’s explicit vision in Revelation connects to Zechariah’s vision:

After this (144,000, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel) I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages . . . **with palm branches in their hands**, and crying out with a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!” (Revelation 7: 9–10)

Our mission is “**Reconciling Disciples with God’s Prophetic Promises to Israel.**” This statement encapsulates what we feel God has called us to accomplish in the world. We hope to contribute to the ultimate reconciliation of two estranged peoples of God: the followers of Yeshua of Nazareth and the Jewish people.

First Fruits of Zion depends on the generous end-of-year contributions of those who share our dream to see the LORD “be king over all the earth . . . and his name one.” We are laboring with you to make God’s name one and bring all of God’s people together in worship. **We long to see his name unified, clarified, and properly honored.**
