

The ancient scroll of the Torah contains the books of Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy—the first five books of the Bible and the foundation on which both Judaism and Christianity stand. *Unrolling the Scroll* opens the Torah and introduces disciples of Jesus to the world of Messianic Jewish Torah study.



The six books of *Unrolling the Scroll* follow the synagogue’s annual Torah reading cycle, providing commentary and insights on the weekly Torah portions which are read in the synagogue from Sabbath to Sabbath.

This unique format makes it possible to study along with the Jewish community, moving through the whole Torah in one year of weekly lessons.

- ✔ **BOOK ONE:** Teaches through the stories of Genesis with faith-building lessons from the lives of Adam, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph.
- ✔ **BOOK TWO:** Teaches through the stories of Exodus with faith-building lessons from the life of Moses, the exodus from Egypt, the giving of the Torah at Sinai, and the construction of the Tabernacle.

- ✔ **BOOK FIVE:** Teaches Deuteronomy’s spiritual truth on the edge of the promised land with lessons from the words of Moses as he prepared the children of Israel for the last stage of their journey.
- ✔ **APPENDICES:** Include additional essays, maps, charts, diagrams, indices, bibliography, and other useful tools to assist you in your study of the Torah.


