Ryan grew up in a Reform Jewish home in the Baltimore-Washington metropolitan area. In college, he came to believe that Jesus is the Jewish Messiah and his life has never been the same since.

Early on as a follower of Jesus, Ryan developed a passion to help Jews and Christians to understand the Jewish roots of Christianity. After graduating from Winthrop University, he went on to get his master's Degree from Liberty University Seminary. Ryan has received ordination as both a pastor and as a Messianic Jewish Rabbi.

Over the years, Ryan has served in the church and the Messianic Jewish movement in various roles. He has planted congregations, spoken in hundreds of churches, led trips to Israel, and has served as a personal assistant to Dr. Michael Brown (author of *Answering Jewish Objections to Jesus*). In addition to Ryan's work with First Fruits of Zion, he also serves as the Messianic Rabbi at Tikvat David Messianic Synagogue in Roswell, Georgia.

As the Director of Outreach, Ryan's role is to connect with pastors and leaders so that First Fruits of Zion can better serve the church and the Messianic Jewish movement in the area of Messianic Judaism and the Jewish roots of the faith.

## RYAN IS AVAILABLE TO SPEAK ON VARIOUS MESSIANIC JEWISH TOPICS WHICH INCLUDE:

**Christ in the Passover:** This presentation teaches through the Passover Seder, highlighting the historical and Messianic significance of each step. Two formats are available: Demonstration (45 mins.) or full meal (2.5 hrs.).

**Christ in the Feasts:** This presentation gives a comprehensive overview of all of the Biblical feasts and their Messianic significance.

Paul within Judaism: Five key points on re-thinking Paul from a Messianic Jewish perspective.

A Messianic Jewish Perspective of the New Testament: Five key points about how a Messianic Jewish viewpoint affects our reading of Jesus and the New Testament.

**The Trei Asar:** This message involves a survey through the Minor Prophets, highlighting their emphasis upon the power of *teshuvah* (repentance) and the relevance of that message for today.

**Answering Jewish Objections to Jesus:** Ryan presents some of the most common Jewish objections to Jesus, provides answers, and then discusses why the redemption of Israel is so important in the unfolding of God's plan for the world.

**Personal Testimony:** Hear Ryan's personal story of how he grew up in a typical American Jewish home and the challenges he faced upon coming to believe in Jesus as the Jewish Messiah.

With any topic, Ryan is willing to do a Q & A session before, after, or as part of his presentation. Series and seminars are also available options.
